1. As discussed by reference (a), the following information is submitted per reference (b):

MAGOFFIN (APA-199) - Ship is being inactivated at INACTSHIPFAC SDIEGO and is expected to be available for transfer to MARAD for lay-up and retention about 10 April 1968. It is desired that lay-up be at SUISUN BAY site.

2. It is requested that a formal request for MARAD to assume custody as indicated in paragraph 1 above be submitted to the Department of Commerce.

Subj: Survey of USS MAGOFFIN (LPA-199), USS TALLADEGA (LPA-208), USS NAVARRO (LPA-215), USS PICKAWAY (LPA-222), USS RENVILLE (LPA-227) and USS BEXAR (LPA-237)

1. USS MAGOFFIN (LPA-199), USS TALLADEGA (LPA-208, USS NAVARRO (LPA-215), USS PICKAWAY (LPA-222), USS RENVILLE (LPA-227) and USS BEXAR (LPA-237) completed construction in 1944. They are stored in the National Defense Reserve Fleet, Suisun Bay, California in the custody of the Maritime Administration.

2. A material inspection of these ships was conducted during the period 12-13 January 1976 and the President, Board of Inspection and Survey has found them unfit for further service. It was recommended that the ships be stricken from the Naval Vessel Register. The Chief of Naval Operations concurs and recommends that the ships be stricken from the Naval Vessel Register on 1 September 1976 as provided for in Title 10, U.S. Code Section 7304.

3. Subsequent to striking, authority is requested to advise MARAD to dispose of these ships as required by Section 484 (i), U.S. Code 40.
